THE TMA GROUP ADVANCES TO PLEDGE LEVEL IN STATE'S TP3 PROGRAM

Franklin, TN- This month, The TMA Group was recognized for its “commitment to positive environmental actions” and advanced to the PLEDGE membership level in the Tennessee Pollution Prevention Partnership (TP3) program.

Facilitated by the Tennessee Department of Environment and Conservation, the TP3 program is described as a network of Tennessee households, schools, government agencies, organizations, businesses, and industries, demonstrating that pollution prevention protects the environment, save money, and improves communities.

To achieve PLEDGE status, The TMA Group completed an inventory of environmental practices to demonstrate pollution prevention in the areas of clean air, energy efficiency/conservation, hazardous materials management/reduction, land and water conservation, and solid waste reduction (reduce, reuse, recycle).

Examples of The TMA Group's environmental practices include:

- Using motion sensor lights in each office to reduce the time each is on; in addition to CFL bulbs installed in ceiling fixtures
- Setting building thermostats on a “non-occupied” setting at night and during the weekend hours
- Using ceramic coffee mugs and glassware for company meetings and events, eliminating disposable tableware
- Managing The Clean Air Partnership of Williamson County, and most recently, The Clean Air Partnership of Rutherford County
- Operating a regional Vanpool Program with 750 riders in 75 vans, eliminating hundreds single occupancy vehicles from the road each day.
